Types of Supplementary Aids and Services	Examples
<p>Accommodations</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Does not change the instructional level or performance criteria</li> <li>• Provides access to information and demonstration of knowledge</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Audio books</li> <li>• A note taker</li> <li>• Use of a laptop</li> <li>• Extended time for assignments or tests</li> <li>• Enlarged print</li> </ul>
<p>Modifications</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Changes what the student is expected to learn</li> <li>• The content remains the same</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Key ideas from a lesson or unit</li> <li>• Same only less</li> <li>• Representative sample of skills</li> </ul>
<p>Paraprofessional Support</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Support given to the individual student as well as all of the other students in the class by an adult</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• One on one support</li> <li>• Small group instruction</li> <li>• Instructional support provided to the teacher</li> <li>• Data collection</li> <li>• Preparation of materials</li> </ul>
<p>Peer Supports</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Utilizing classmates to provide support in ways that enhance the learning of both the student with and without a disability</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Paired reading</li> <li>• Quiz review</li> <li>• Presentations</li> <li>• Group work</li> </ul>
<p>Assistive Technology</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Low tech and high tech materials and software used to provide access to learning and demonstration of content</li> <li>• Includes Augmentative Alternative Communication (AAC) devices</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Calculator</li> <li>• Reading strips</li> <li>• Highlighter tape</li> <li>• Book stands</li> <li>• Fidget toy</li> <li>• Raised line paper</li> <li>• Word prediction software</li> <li>• Lap top</li> </ul>
<p>Related Service Providers</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Professionals who push into the classroom to provide support with specific goals and/or needs</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Physical therapist</li> <li>• Speech therapist</li> <li>• Occupational therapist</li> <li>• Vision specialist</li> <li>• Nurse</li> </ul>
